INSTRUCTIONS

This worksheet is to be completed by Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and North Dakota Homeless Grant (NDHG) program staff to document household income eligibility when required. Rapid Rehousing households do not have to income qualify at program entrance but must have an income below 30% AMI at annual recertification. Homeless Prevention households must income qualify for assistance at initial and recertification every 3 months. ESG and NDHG have different income requirements: ESG Funding 30% AMI also called Extremely Low Income - NDHG Funding at 50% AMI also called Very Low Income.
